

Hello from Tomnah'a Market Garden,

You're seeing this email because you were a member of our CSA box share in the 2019 season or have expressed an interest about getting a weekly box from us this season.

A massive thank you for supporting our fledgling business and sharing our passion for fresh, seasonal, local produce that you can trust is free from any nasty chemicals.

All 2020 members will receive a 10% discount on all items at the Comrie Croft Farm Shop - valid for the whole year. Once you have confirmed you are wanting to receive a weekly share from Tomnah'a, **please head over to the farm shop where you will be given a membership card and you can begin your discounted shopping right away!**

- **Main Season:**

26 weeks starting Friday May 22nd running to Friday 13th November

- **Prices:**

Small box - at least 6 portions - £8 / week

Med box - at least 9 portions - £12 / week

Large box - at least 12 portion - £16 / week

- **Eggs:**

are available to pre-order with the boxes - and some will generally be available to purchase on the day **£2.20 / 6 or £4.20 / 12**

- **Packing and collecting:**

To be packed and collected from the big shed at Tomnah'a Market Garden on:

friday afternoon / evening 3 - 6.30

saturday morning 8.30 - 12.30

- **Delivery:**

If unable to pack and collect (or arrange with friends to share the task) **we can provide delivery service if within the Comrie / Crieff area** for a small charge relative to time / distance

Please come along and help pack your box - there will be a set list of items each week and you can get hands on with the veg and weigh out your veggies -

Coming along to make up your box will also give you the opportunity to pick up any extras we may have available and there will be a swap out box. This gives you a bit of flexibility and choice and the chance to grab some extras as a thank you for coming to help make up your box. There will generally be one of us around to help you out if needed.

- **Payment:**

Preferred payment would be through bank transfer.

Please indicate on the sign up form whether you would prefer to be invoiced for the full season up front, half the season upfront and again midway through or a monthly invoice. We will issue the monthly invoices in arrears.

- **What happens if i'm away?**

Why not offer a friend, family member or neighbour the box for those weeks?

- **Can I trial a box with you?**

Of course, if we have availability please sign up for a month and we can take it from there

- **I'd love to come and see the farm, and perhaps volunteer with you**

Amazing! We'd encourage all our box members and other non-member customers to come meet us and see the farm for themselves and see all the lovely produce in the field or in the tunnels. Coming to pack and collect the box is a massive help for us and will only take a few minutes once we have got the system up and running.

We'd love you all to come and volunteer with us at some point through the season. We will hold regular volunteer days / work parties / harvest parties and a few big shout outs for help with some big jobs through the year. This gives you the opportunity to get your hands in the soil which is good for your mind, body and soul!

- **I'd like to volunteer on a regular basis**

Fantastic! We realise not everyone will have the time to commit to this but if you are keen to give some time on a regular basis we'd be delighted. We already have a small team of wonderful volunteers that come and help out (usually on a thursday) and we are so grateful and lucky to have them on board. There is potential for a veg box in exchange for volunteering some time on a regular basis. Please let us know if you are interested.

- **I don't think I can eat that many vegetables!**

Why not share a box with a friend? That way if one person is away the other can take the whole box that week too!

- **Whats going to be in the box?**

Seasonal, super fresh produce! A mixture of roots, leaves and fruiting crops that moves and changes with the seasons as certain crops become available, boxes will be varied and always have a balance of different crop types and may occasionally contain some unusual veg (think kohlrabi, tomatillos, Jerusalem artichokes etc) but we will try and include some staple crops all weeks and provide some yummy recipe ideas for those more unusual items!

We won't give you all the same produce every week and each box will have between 8 - 12 different items. Some items will feature regularly such as cherry tomatoes, salads when in season, others like brussel sprouts or kohlrabi less so.

- **Is it ok to cancel my box?**

If it's not working out for whatever reason, we would ask you to give us a bit of notice and/or perhaps help us find a replacement member.

We will continue to stock the Farm Shop at Comrie Croft with a great range of our produce for you to buy as and when you need.
